

THE ARTICULATION OF THE UN WATERCOURSES CONVENTION WITH OTHER AREAS OF INTERNATIONAL LAW

ABSTRACT

The presentation will look at issues beyond the entry into force of the UN Watercourses Convention in order to strengthen its relevance in the coming years. It will examine the relationship between the Convention and norms of other areas of international law, i.e. international environmental law and human rights law. Emphasis will be given to international practice, which highlights ways to reconcile the interpretation of an international instrument with subsequent developments of international law. Examples will include case law of international tribunals such as the International Court of Justice and the Permanent Court of Arbitration.
