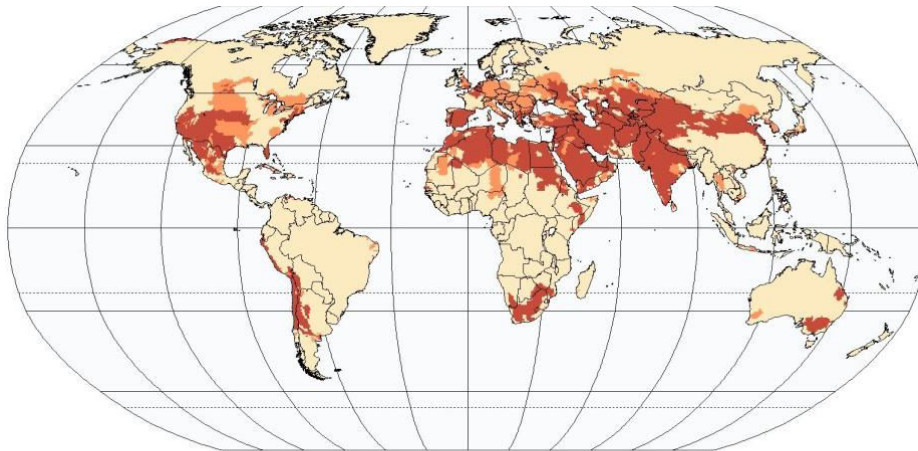
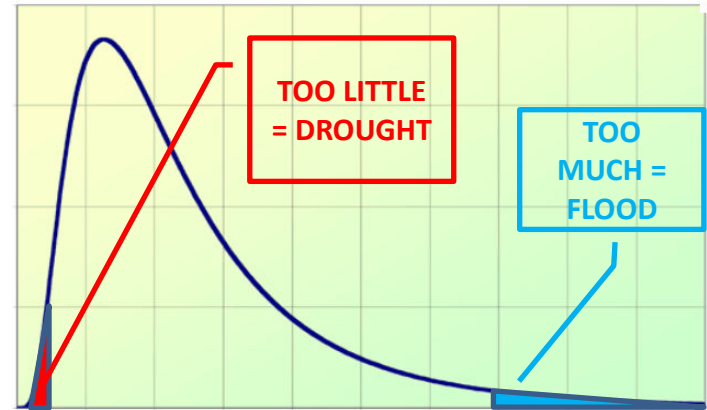

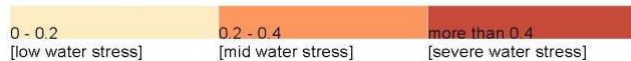

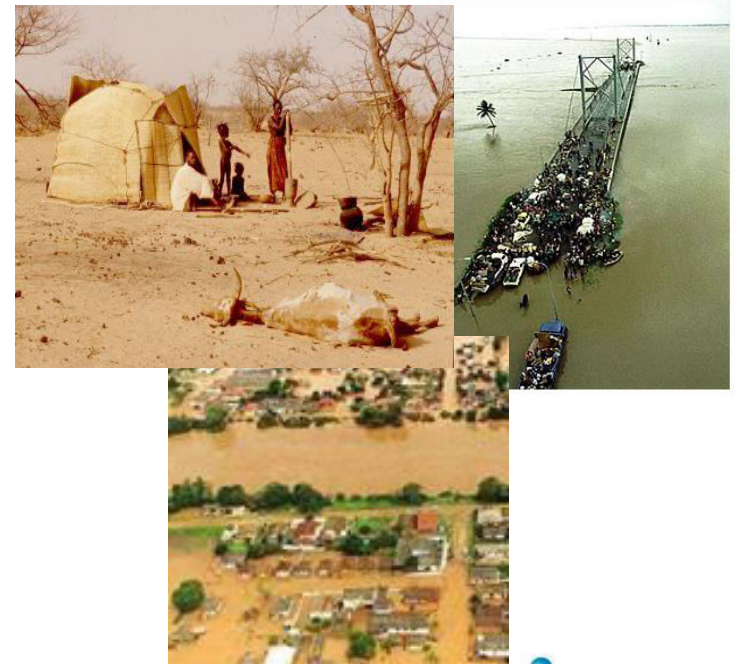

Map 6. Water stress according to drainage basins, circa 1995 [withdrawal-to-availability ratio]



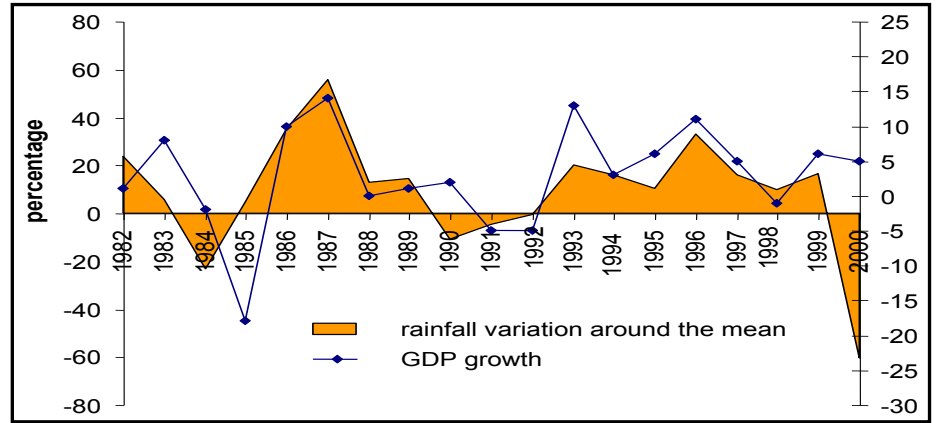

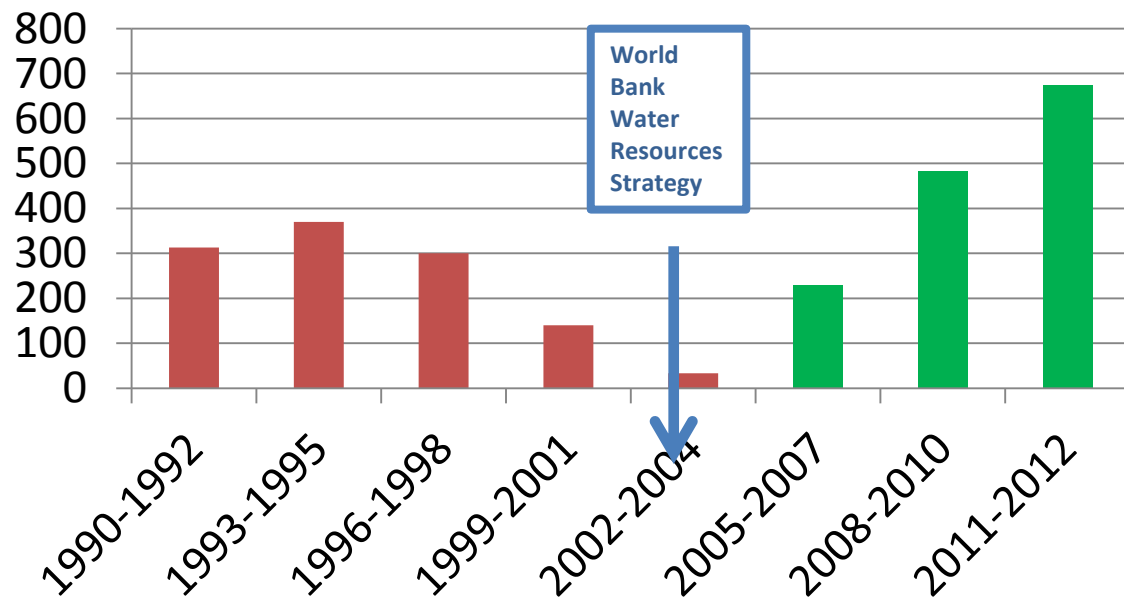




- Multi-purpose infrastructure
