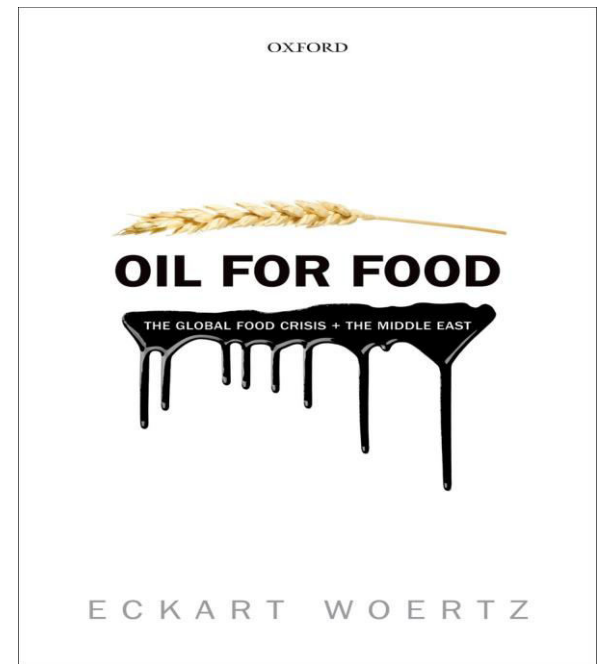
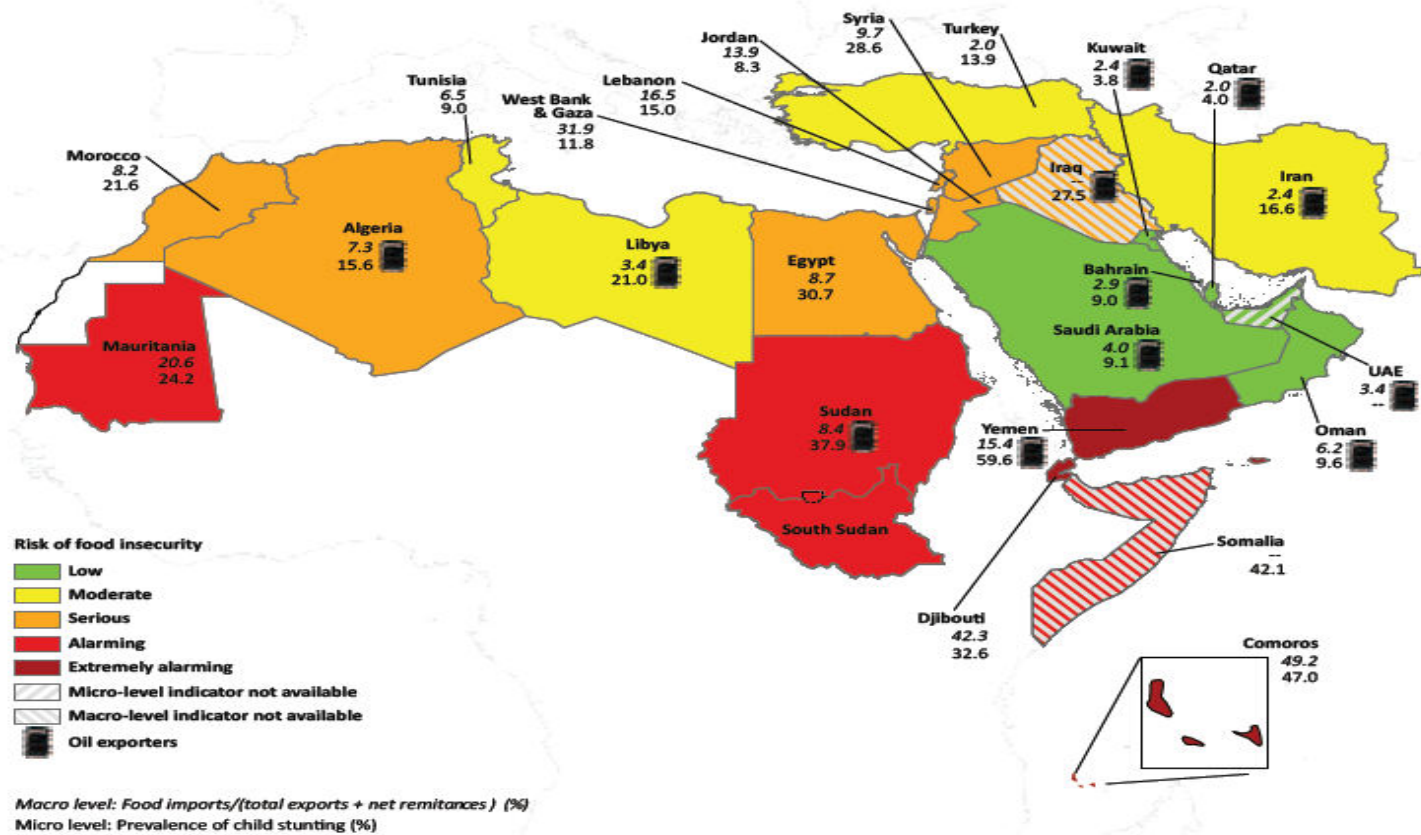




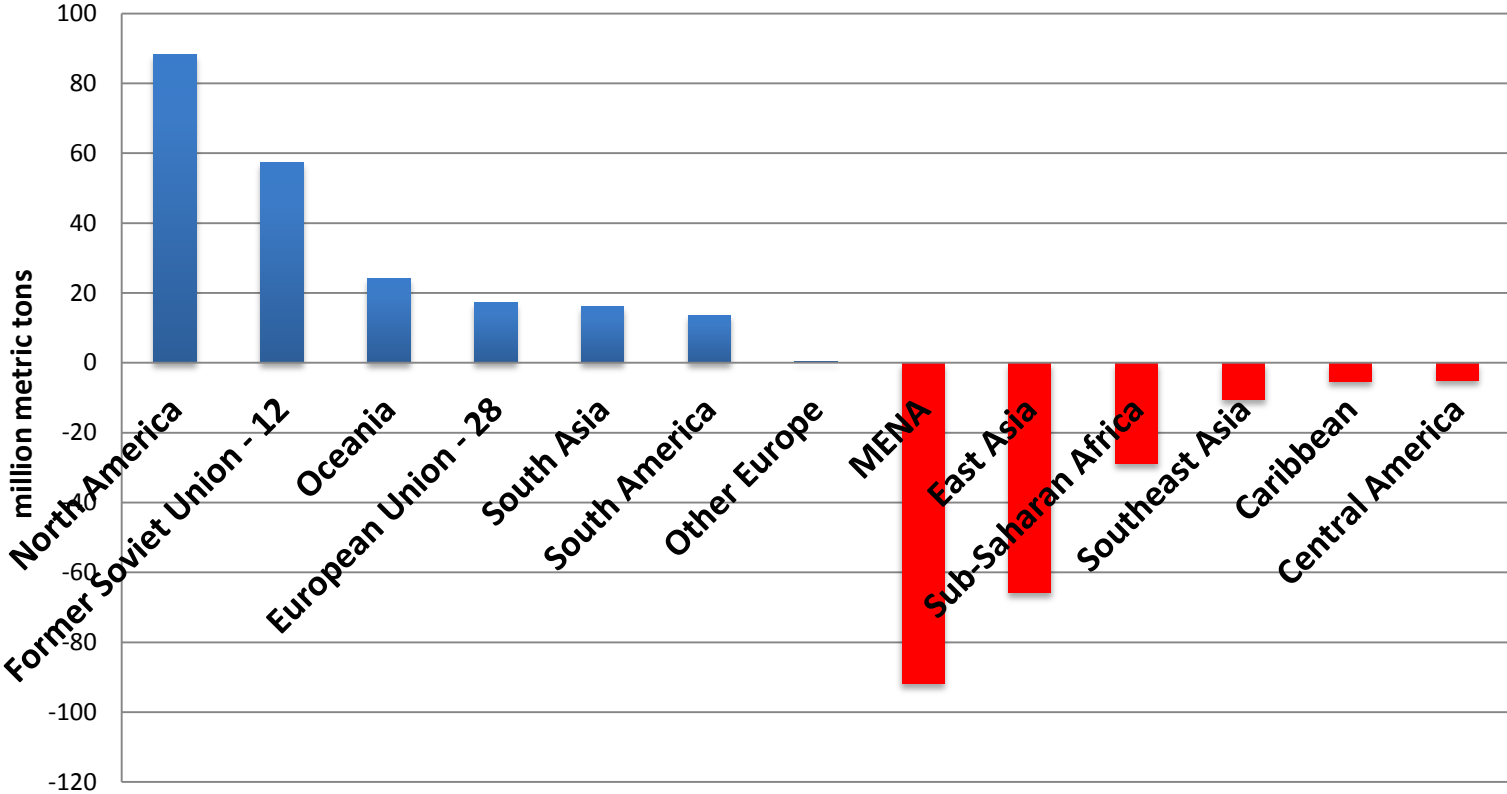
Figure 4—The risk of food insecurity in Arab-TI countries

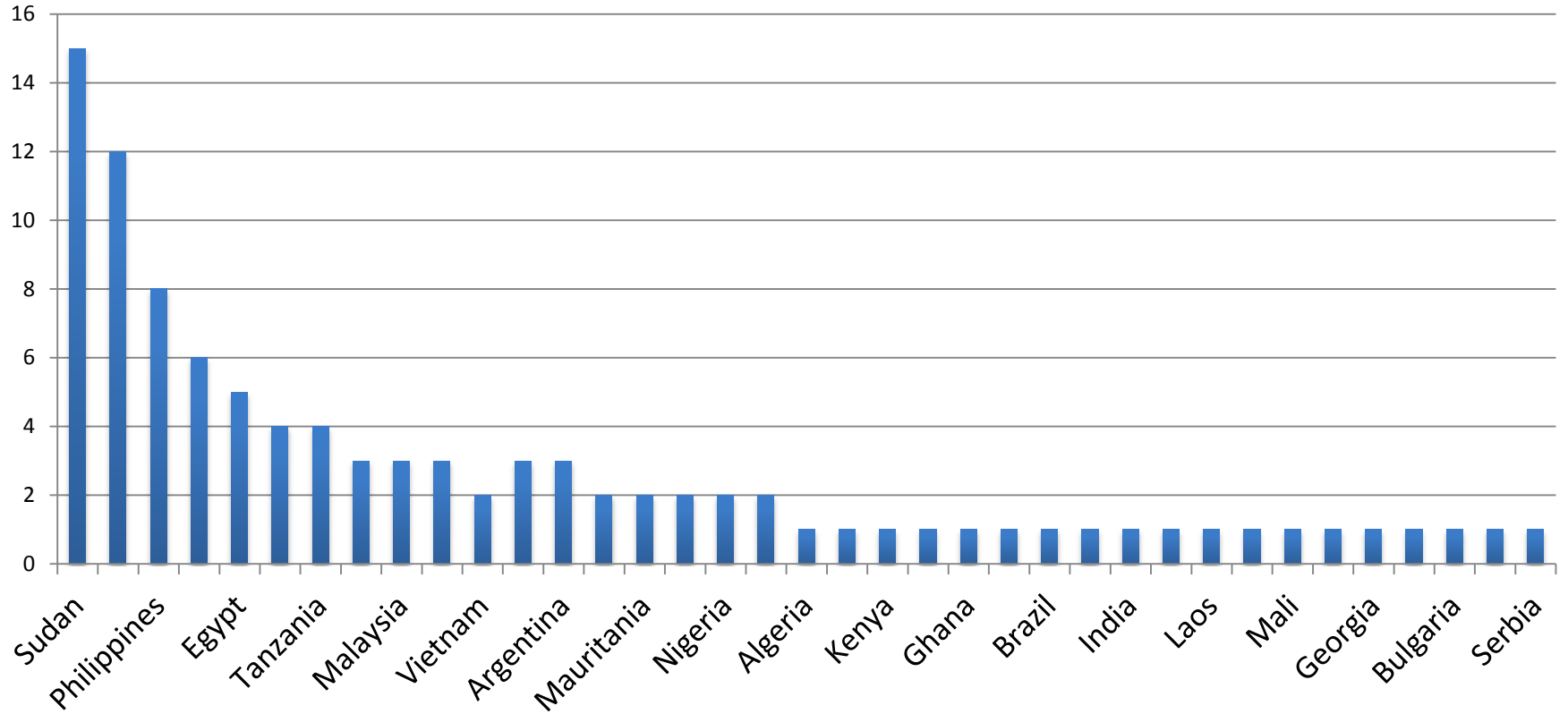

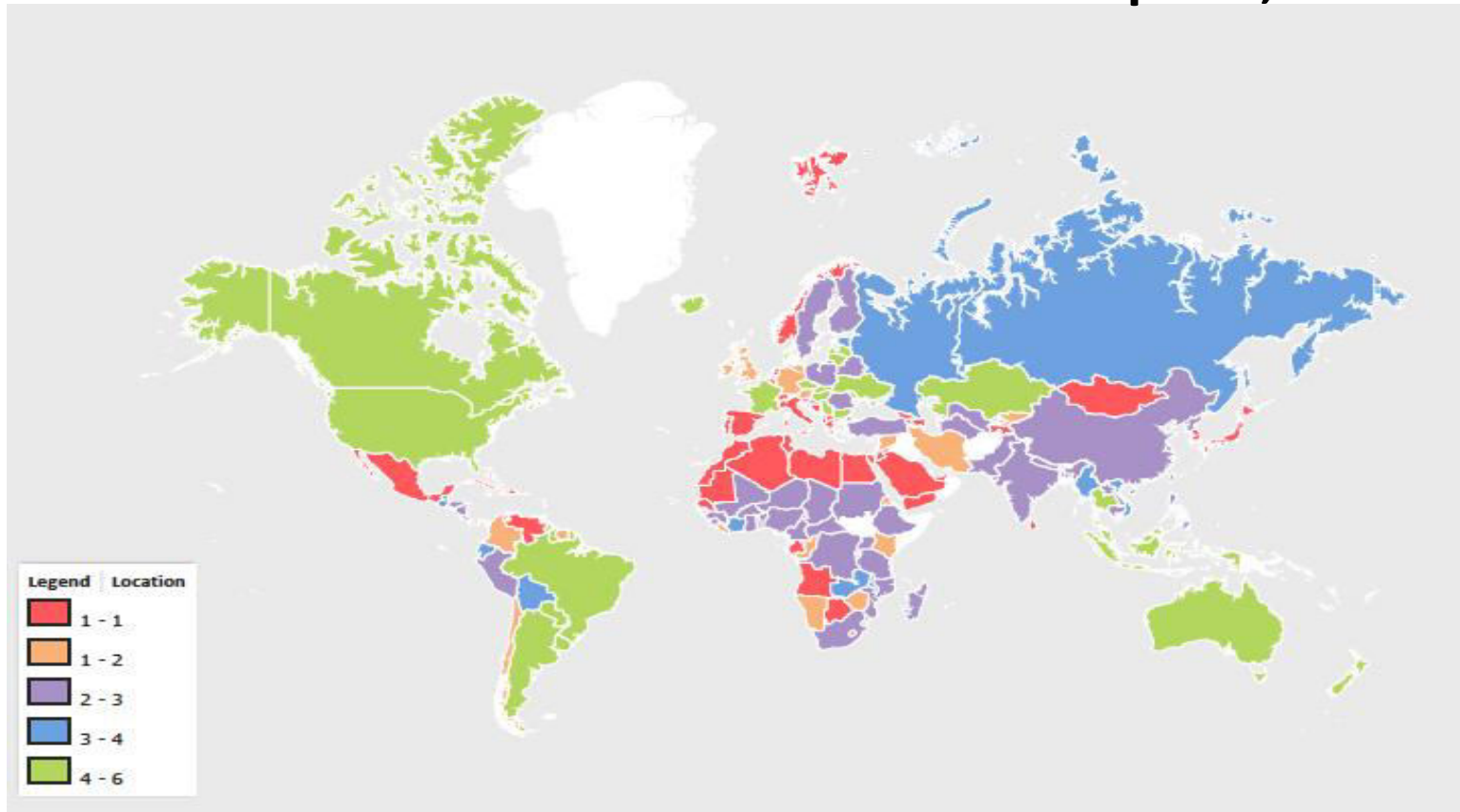

Number of ANNOUNCED GCC Agro-Investments Abroad 2008-2012

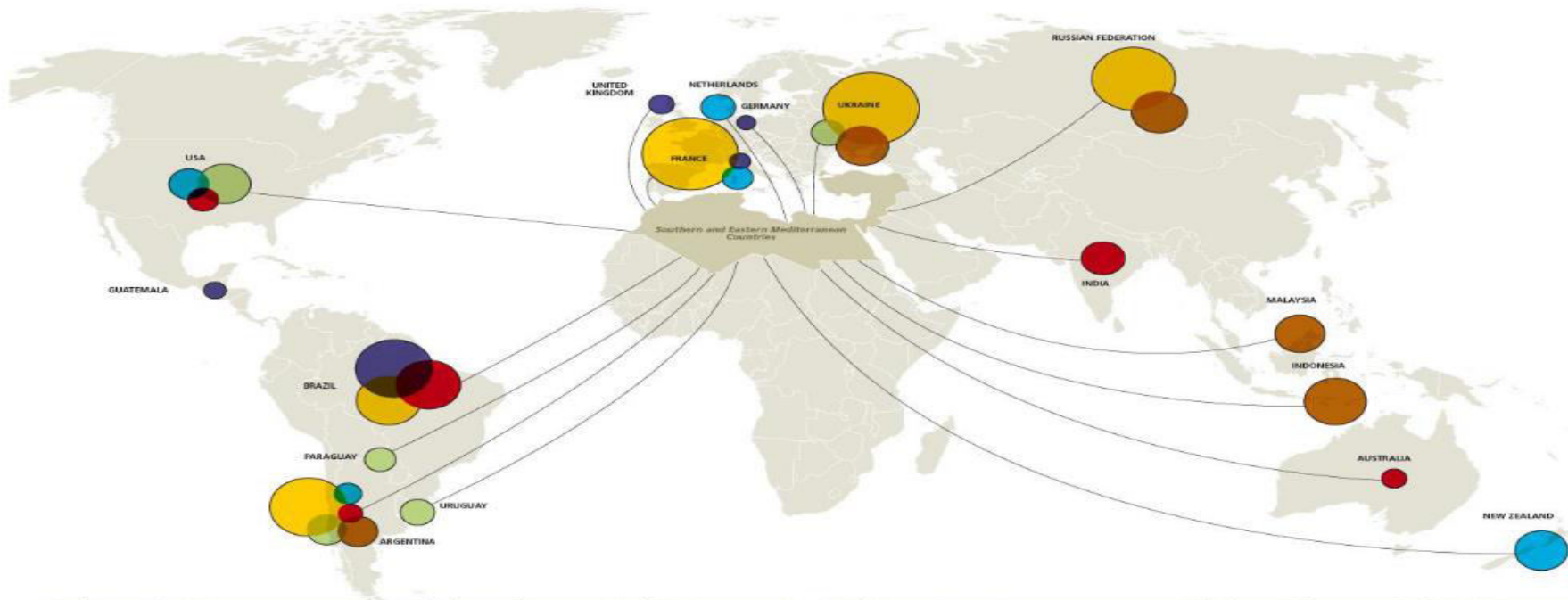
