

Multi-level Regime:

1.International Water Law:

bi-/multilateral agreements (UNECE, Danube, Rhine etc.)

2.EU Water Law:

- 2000 Water Framework Directive
- daughter directives etc.

framework agreement:

1992 UNECE Water Convention

specific agreements:

1994 Danube Convention, 1999 Rhine Convention etc.

approach:

- drainage basin
- integrated water resources management


- **adoption**: 28 EU Member States + European Parliament
- legally binding on EU Member States
- **implementation** by EU Member States
 - **judicial review** by European Court of Justice
 - enforcement by European Commission
 - domestic + transboundary water bodies

EU Water Framework Directive


- surface water + groundwater
