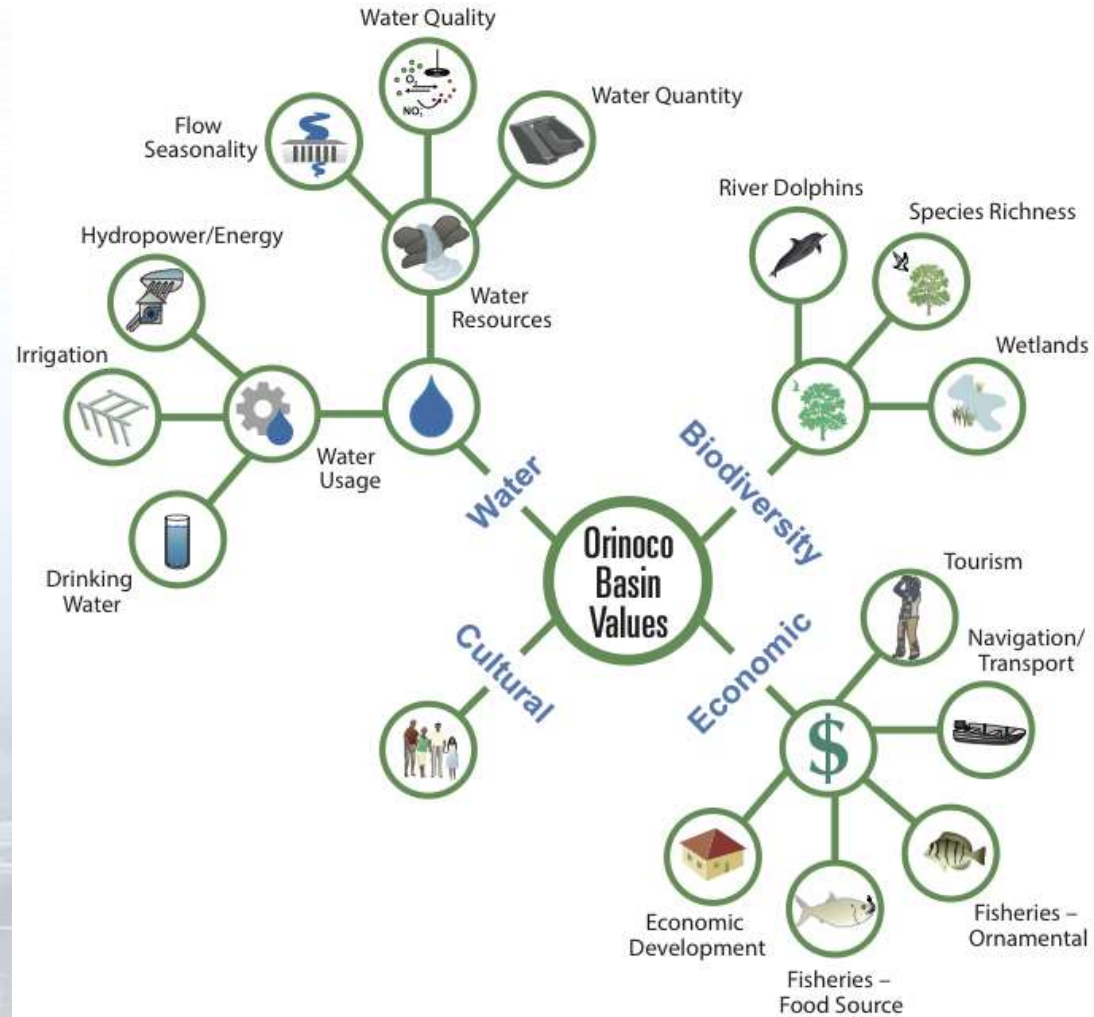
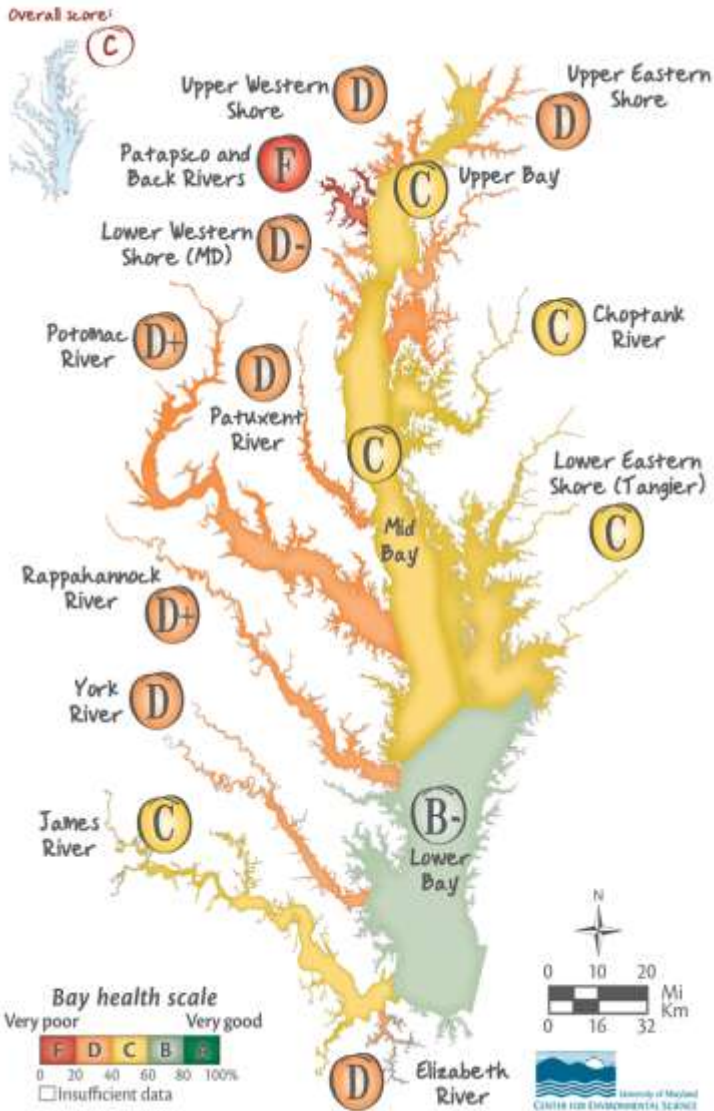
Secure Water for People and Nature

By 2025, improve or maintain the health of the world's major basins for people and nature, contributing to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.



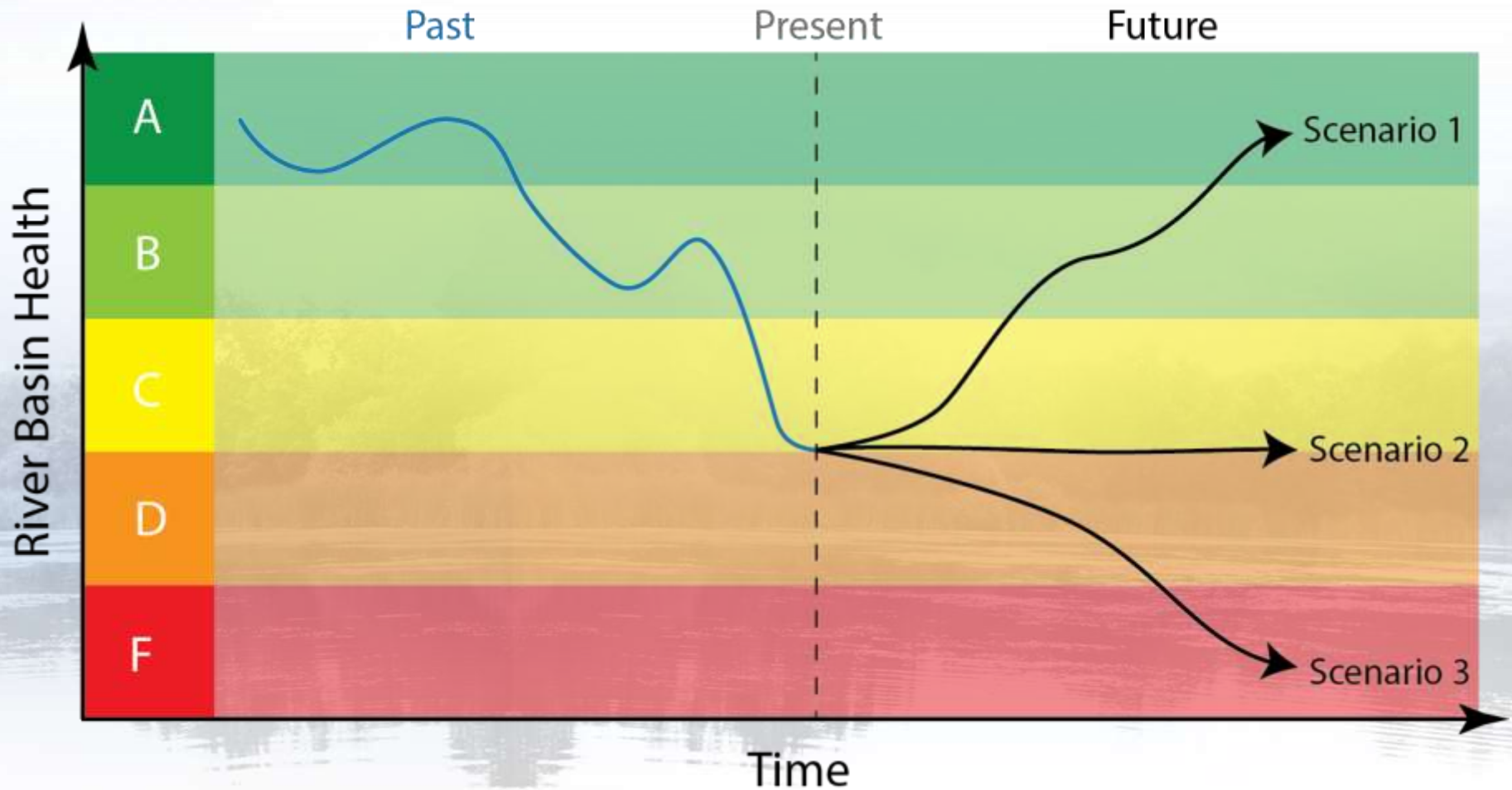


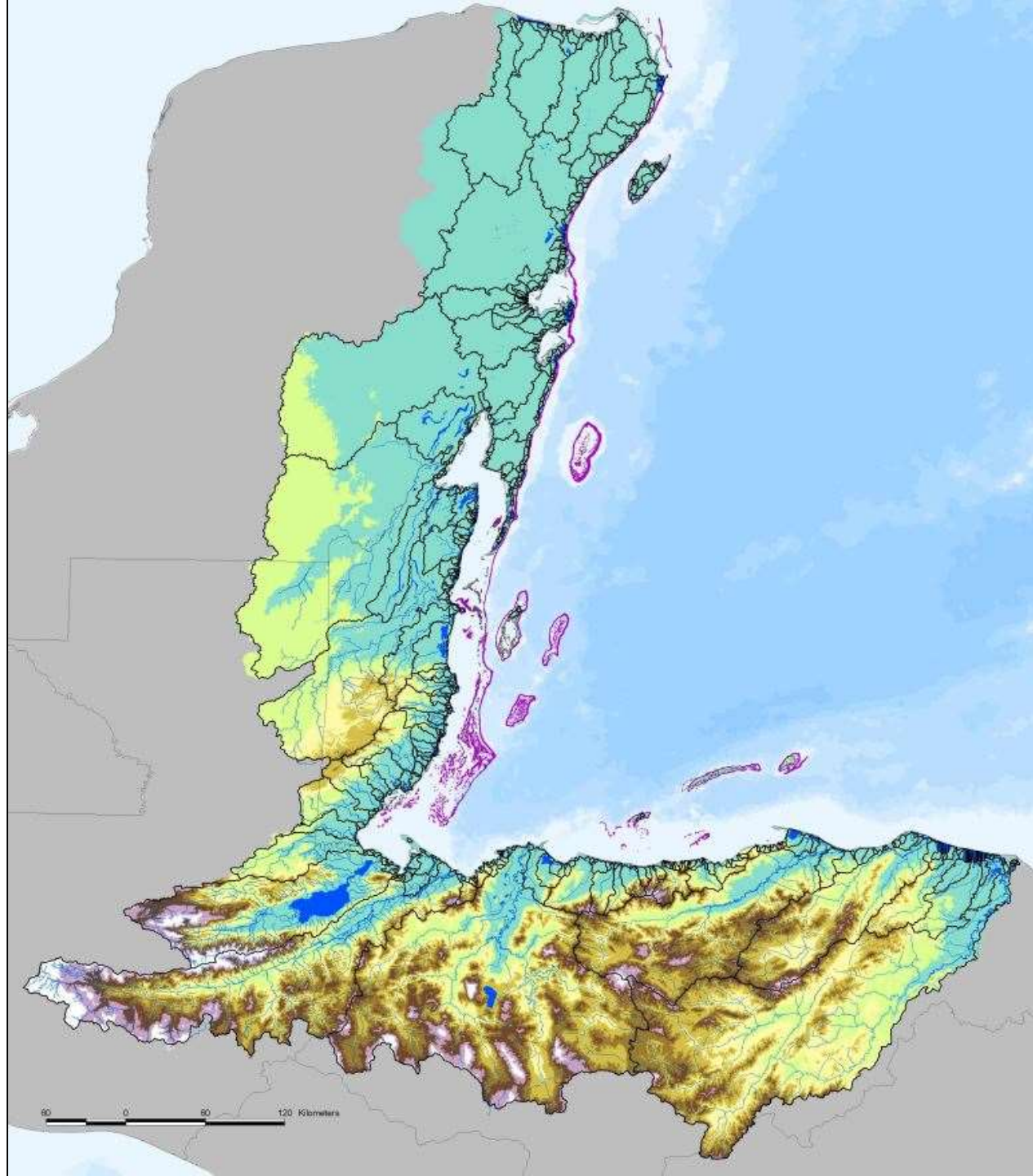

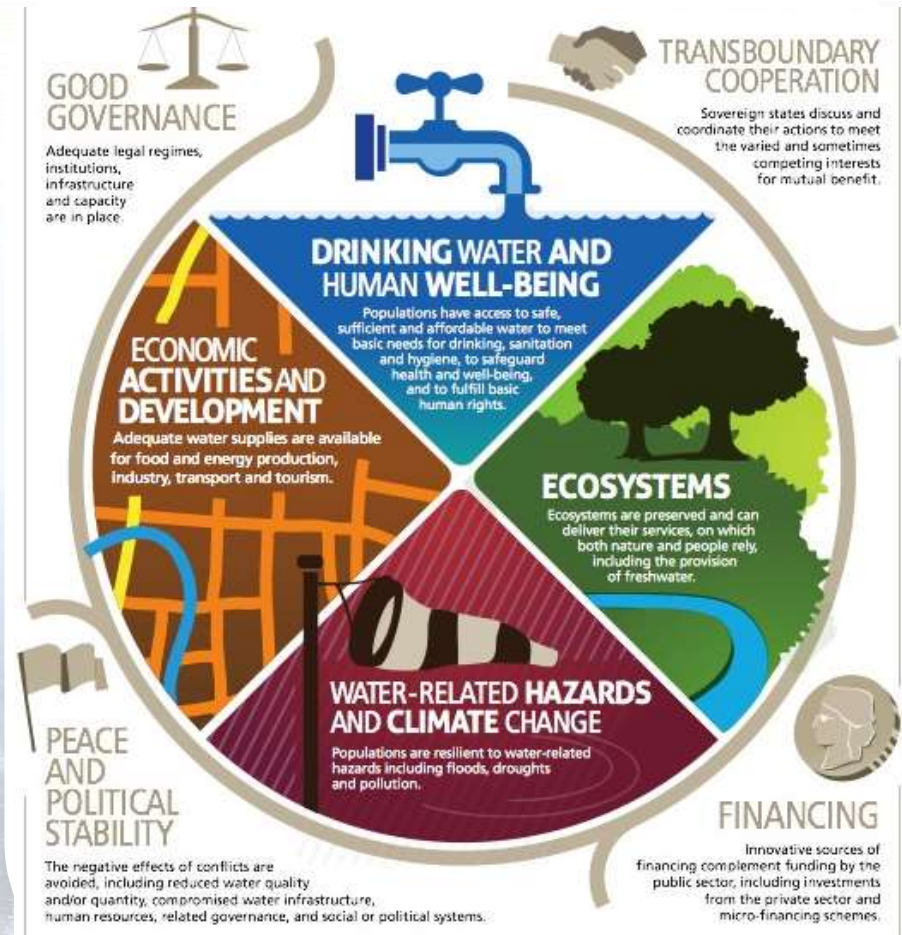
MDGs
