## Objectives

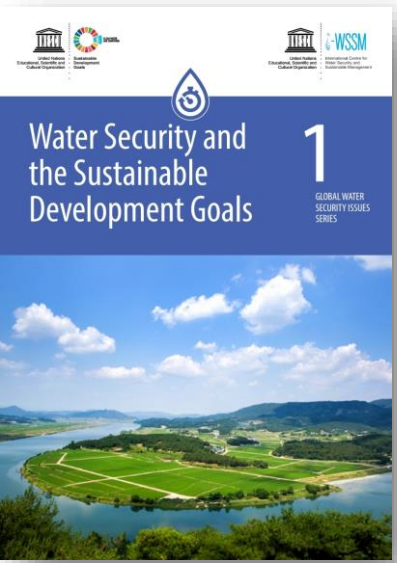
- **To share the current issues**

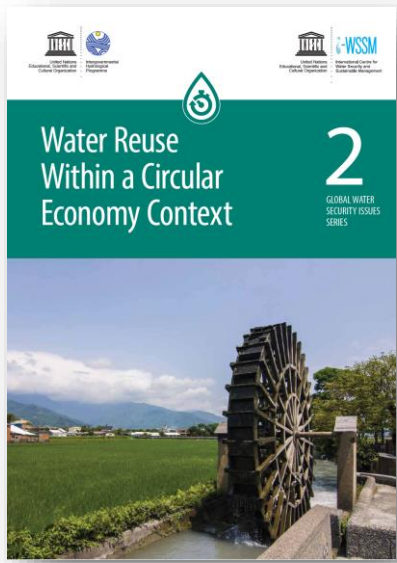
